Merritt said he is concerned over the long-term legality of selling Kinko's packets at the University because the court ruling does not explicitly allow it. While the ruling does restrict private companies such

as Kinko's from reproducing some material under the fair use clause, it does not specifically grant immunity from those restrictions to public institutions like the University, he said.

"I think next fall, you'll see a lot less packets being prepared," Merritt said.

homes," Wagner said. "The Hunger Cleanup is a way in which students can work together to solve these problems."

Wagner said local agencies were pleased with the efforts of the workers.

"These people that were running the shelters and the people living there were just amazed at the work the volunteers were doing," he said. "They realized that the people involved really aren't going to just forget about them for the next twelve months."

Hunger Cleanup co-ordinator Nave Schildbach said that in addition to raising money, the event was intended to educate students about the extent of hunger and homelessness in Lane County. He explained that many students imagine the problem as being limited to the few homeless people in the University area.

"A lot of people are aware of the problem, but maybe the only people they see are the people on 13th," Schildbach said. "They don't see the kids, and the parents who've lost their jobs and don't have any where to go."

Citing a lack of government funds for hunger programs, Schildbach said local shelters and agencies are often the only place that hungry and homeless people can turn.

"Agencies like these are the only barrier between absolutely nothing for these people and food and shelter," he said. "If these agencies weren't there and weren't doing the work, then these people would have nothing at all."

Half of the money raised by the Hunger Cleanup will be split by White Bird Clinic and Looking Glass Shelter, two local service agencies, and the rest will go to various national and international hunger programs.

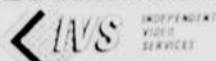
