will have two years of eligibility at Oregon.

"We're looking for him to be the kind that can run the break," Monson said of Collier, "set up the offense and distribute the ball, make good decisions and run the ball club."

"Andre's the type of kid who knows how to run the ball club," he said. "The stats of scoring and assists speak for themselves. He's proven himself by being the MVP of his league."

The marquee player might likely be Reece who was also last season's Gatorade Rocky Mountain Region Player of the Year.

The 6-3 Reece averaged 35.1 points, 8.3 assists, 7.4 rebounds and 4.3 steals per game this past year in leading Manual High School in Denver to three state championships in four seasons, including winning the state crown his junior and senior years.

"I don't think I've ever recruited a guy that averaged 35 points, eight assists, seven rebounds and four steals a

game," Monson said. "You can't say enough about his abilities."

"The thing that impressed me," he said, "is that three out of the four years they won the state championships, and he played a lot and started all the time since his freshman year."

The Ducks beat out such national powers as Seton Hall, Louisville, Arkansas and New Mexico in signing Reece. In fact, Monson was at a Manual practice in September that Seton Hall Coach P.J. Carlesimo also attended.

While there was a lot of na-

tional interest in Reece during the fall, Monson said a lot of schools backed off when Reece held off in making his decision.

"He decided he wanted to get it over with," Monson said. "... I think it worked out better for us," that Reece held off on his decision.

Both the signings of Collier and Reece were obviously influenced somewhat by Brandon's decision to enter the draft, Monson said.

"It's hard to say," Monson said. "The kids look at the situation, and everyone thinks they can play immediately and take

over."

Monson said his staff might not have signed Collier if Brandon had stayed for his senior season, but were intent on signing Reece if possible.

"We would have stayed on Reece pretty hard," he said. "Quite frankly, we most likely would have backed off Collier."

The Ducks have now inked six players for next season after signing four forwards during the early signing period in the fall.

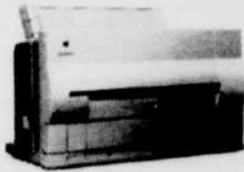
