Nobody in the Cowboy front office could be reached for comment Sunday night.

Bellotti said he thinks Musgrave could have made whatever team he was drafted by.

"Bill has a darn good chance of making any team," he said. "I think Bill has a great chance to make the team because he's so intelligent and he has the ability that he can be a performer there like he was here."

The biggest knock on Musgrave by many of the pro scouts was that he didn't have the strong arm necessary to make it as a pro quarterback, but Bellotti said Musgrave can get stronger and believes Musgrave is just now fully recovered from a broken collarbone injury he suffered his sophomore season.

"He was never really able to come back (to full strength) until the last two or three months when he's been able to put on some weight," Bellotti said.
