The musical comedy, based on Studs Terkel's book of the same name, will be performed by Mainstage Theatre Company throughout the rest of the week.

Mainstage is a production company that has made its mark in Eugene's drama circle at the Hult Center.

The story is taken from Terkel's compilation of 136 interviews with people working in various fields.

The musical features the lives of a steelworker, a homemaker, a corporate executive and migrant workers, among others.

"There is something for everyone in *Working*," said theater director Jim Roberts. "Many people who see it say they can relate to two or three charac-

ters while doing necessary work."

Still in its first season, the Willamette Street Theater has featured a variety of events since its Feb. 22 opening at the newly renovated building on 10th Avenue and Willamette Street.

It has been aptly coined "Oregon's newest arts complex" for the vast choices it offers for visual enjoyment. The theater's variety is seen in its gallery for art display, international cinema showings, timely plays, family theater and late night comedy.
