

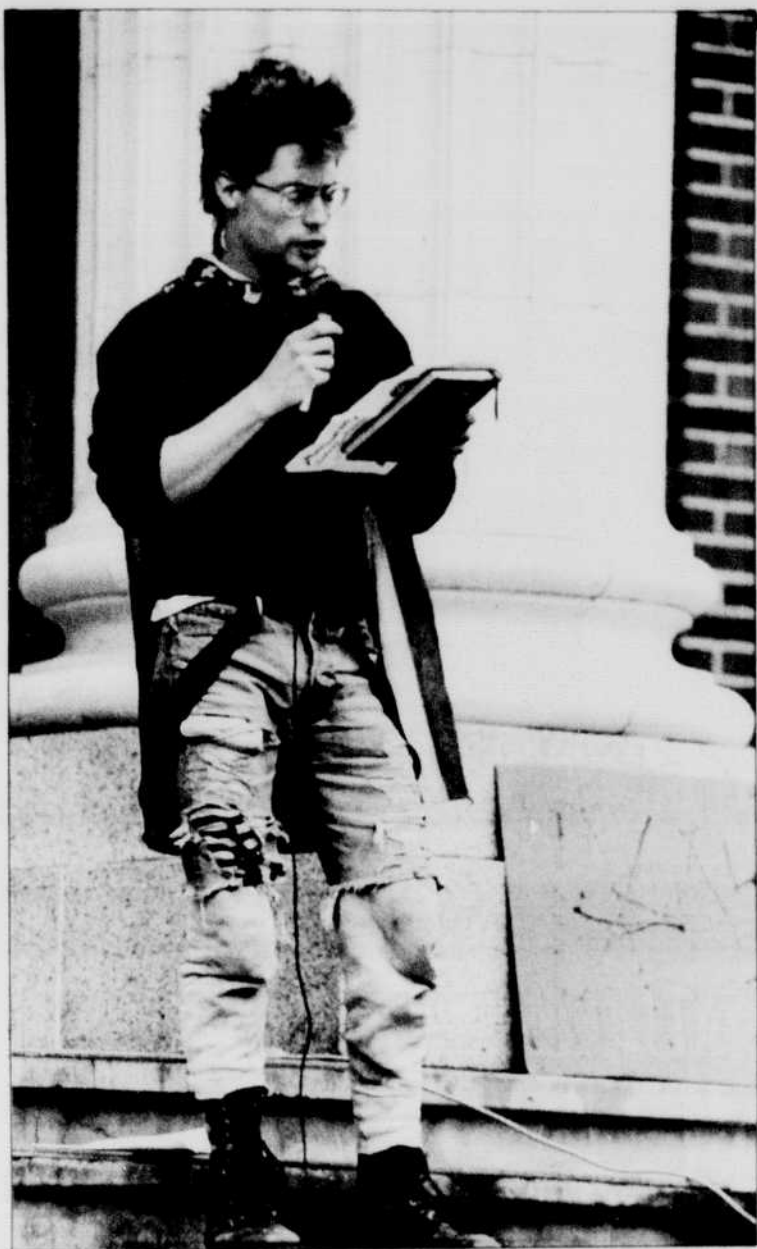

dent Myles Brand of doing nothing to stop discrimination on campus.

"There is no reason why he can't uphold the Oregon Administrative Rules, which prohibit discrimination," Oliver said.

Oliver said California's chancellor of state colleges and universities called defense Secretary Dick Cheney to complain

about the military's discriminatory policy.

Bo Adan, a University graduate teaching fellow, said although it is important to try to end military discrimination against gays and lesbians, and to push legislation allowing women to participate in front-line combat, students need to consider the larger picture.

"It does not seem a measure of equality that gays, lesbians and women can fight and kill just as men do," he said.

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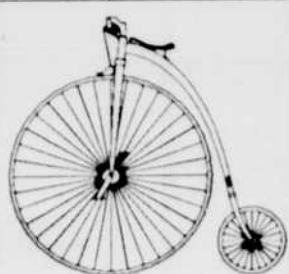
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
