HISTORY

The University established the first fraternity, Sigma Nu, on campus in 1901. The first sorority here was Gamma Phi Beta which received its charter in 1908. The popularity of Greek life grew rapidly till the 1960s when there were 22 fraternities and 16 sororities on cam-

In the late 1960s membership dropped dramatically. Fourteen houses closed within six years. By late 1970, six percent of University students were in the Greek system. The system has regained its hold here, though,

and is in the process of adding two new fraternities and has recently chartered two new soronties in the past year.

GREEK WEEK

Greek Week, held each spring, is a chance for fraternity and sorority members to participate in a wide variety of events on and off campus.

This year's Greek Week, held the week of May 14-19, featured an airband/lipsync competition, serenade night, participation in University Day, a variety show, the annual cance fete where original floats are created and displayed on the Millrace and a Greek awards banquet.


