Announcement of Graduate Teaching Fellowship for the Savage Professorship in International Relations and Peace

The committee which selects the distinguished Savage Professor is pleased to announce an opening for a graduate teaching fellow to assist next year's Savage Professor, Professor Yoshikazu Sakamoto, Professor of Peace and World Order Studies at the International Peace Research Institute Meigaku in Japan. The GTF will assist Sakamoto in teaching a large undergraduate class tentatively titled Key Issues in Peace Studies and a smaller graduate seminar focusing on approaches to Peace Studies and Peace Research. The GTF will also work with the Savage Committee and its chair during the summer in preparing for Sakamoto's teaching during the fall. The GTF will be .20 FTE for the summer, .49 for the fall, and .20 for the winter. The GTF should be a graduate student at the UO in a field related to Sakamoto's courses and expertise such as history, economics, sociology, geography, peace studies, public policy and planning, international studies, anthropology, and political science. Previous experience in working with Japanese and/or Asian nationals would also be helpful. Those interested in applying should submit a current vita, including names of three references with phone numbers; a current transcript; and a short essay indicating why you would like to work with Professor Sakamoto. Applications should be submitted to the Office of International Affairs, Johnson Hall (attention Lynn Butting, 346-2167) no later than May 22.
