Top teachers honored

Tired of dealing with boring, uninspiring professors? Feel like your teachers would rather be doing research than coming to class? Then think about signing up for a class taught by Frances Cogan, Alexander Murphy or Steve Owen.

All three professors are recipients of the University's top teaching awards for 1991.

Murphy, assistant geography professor, and Owen, assistant music professor, have won annual Ersted Awards for Distinguished Teaching, Cogan, an associate professor in the Honors College, is the winner of the Burlington Northern Foundation Faculty Achievement Award for Teaching Excellence.

The three faculty members will be recognized during spring commencement ceremonies at Autzen Stadium June 9.

The Burlington Northern Foundation Faculty Achievement Awards program at the University is one of 70 supported nationally by the foundation. This year the award includes a \$2,500 honorarium.

A University faculty member since 1981, Cogan is a nationally recognized expert on 19th century American literature who specializes in women's writing and American studies.

While working for her doctoral degree in 1979, Cogan received a University Graduate Teaching Fellow Award. She also won an Ersted award in 1985.

In addition to teaching freshman honors classes in literature, she has developed and taught courses in 19th century fiction, the historical novel and utopian fiction.
