Louisiana State wins another NCAA title

If Louisiana State did not establish itself as a track dynasty with its fourth consecutive national title last year, it did so with its fifth this year

The Tigers successfully defended their 1990 championship by winning the women's NCAA Track and Field Championships Saturday at Hayward Field. LSU finished first with 78 points to second-place Texas' 67 points.

"This is a great one," LSU Coach Pat Henry said. "Every year is a little bit different."

First, second and fifth-place finishes Saturday afternoon in the 100 hurdles sealed the Tigers' title early. LSU's Dawn Bowles, Mary Cobb and Cinnamon Sheffield took those spots. respectively, and their efforts earned the Tigers 22 points.

"It's just all coming together

for me - I'm overwhelmed that it is," said Bowles, who tied the Hayward Field record with her semifinal time Friday (12.82) and won in a wind-aid ed 12.70 Saturday.

Senior sprinter Esther Jones pulled in 16 big points, finishing second in both the 100and 200-meter dash in 10.99 and 22.57. Jones was also the anchor on the second-place 4x100 relay team that finished in 42.96.

'Esther Jones has been on four championship teams," Henry said, "and there's not many NCAA athletes that get that opportunity.

Beating Jones in all three events was Texas' Carlette Guidry, who won the 100 in 10.91 and the 200 in 22.44. Guidry's sprint past Jones in the 4x100 helped Texas win the relay, and the 42.88 relay time was a new Hayward record.

- · "How's this for passing the baton ... keeping it in the SEC." - Tennessee Coach Doug Brown to reporters when LSU Coach Pat Henry shook his hand for taking the men's title from two-time champ Louisiana State.
- 'How'd you do? I went and got a Coke and didn't see." - Arkansas Coach Lance Harter joking to 10,000-meter winner Jamie Park.
- "If you look good, you feel good. If you feel good, you run fast. We think we look good and obviously we run fast." - Texas Christian sprinter Horatio Porter on the full-length body suits TCU wore while winning the 4x100meter relay for the fourth time in six years.
- "I was running my own race. I didn't think about the other competitors or you screw your own race." - Nebraska sprinter Ximena Restrepo, who pulled one of the meet's biggest upsets in the 400 meters, beating defending champ Maicel Malone of Arizona State.
