

# HOLLAND

Not everyone agrees with Wessells' assessment, however. Last year, the ASUO and the Lesbian, Gay and Bisexual Alliance publicly called for Holland's resignation after Greg Johnson, a law school professor, was asked to apologize to his class for briefly discussing his homosexuality during a lecture.

Although Holland was apparently not directly responsible for the request, LGBA Co-director Sue Dockstader said at the time that Holland was at fault for not taking action and issuing an apology on behalf of the administration.

In another incident two weeks ago, the U.S. Department of Education ruled that Holland had twice violated the

Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, a federal law designed to protect the privacy of a student's academic records.

The ruling was made following a complaint filed by former law student Willy Bills, who in 1987 submitted as his own a paper that he not write. The ruling stated that Holland violated the law by showing the paper to the real author during a meeting and to a Eugene police sergeant. No disciplinary action was required, however.

During the past school year, the American Bar Association threatened to remove the school's accreditation, citing a lack of improvement to law school facilities, limited financial support, an inadequate teacher to student ratio, among other things.

In May, however, the ABA accepted the University's proposal to upgrade conditions.

ASUO President Jennifer Bills said she is pleased that Holland is resigning as dean, but is concerned that he is staying on as a faculty member.

"If the way he handled being a dean is an indication of the way he will handle being a professor, then there is reason to be concerned for gay and lesbian law students," she said.

"I hope there won't be any backlash against the students who were involved in the protests after the Greg Johnson incident," Bills said.

Wessells said a search committee is being appointed to find a replacement for Holland, and that a new dean will be appointed as early as January if a state-

wide search is successful. If the committee fails to find an Oregon candidate, a national search will be launched in September.

June 1992 will be the latest Holland would be on the job, Wessells said.

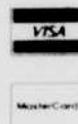
Former gubernatorial candidate and Oregon Attorney General Dave Frohnmayer is rumored to be a possible replacement. Although his executive assistant, Marla Rae, said Frohnmayer is planning a possible career move, nothing is definite yet.

"We'll know by the end of the year what lies ahead in Dave's future," she said. "He's indicated that he will make a change. ... There are a number of things that are possibilities."
