would not say how much Jolin paid for the car. He told the Eugene Register-Guard a brand new Nissan 300ZX would have cost between \$25,000 and \$30,000.

Jolin said she traded in a 1989 Nissan as part of the down payment to buy the car. She said the \$10,000 borrowed from the campaign was used to renegotiate terms of a loan so that her interest rate and payments would be reduced.

She said her father in Arizo-

na had promised to lend her the money at 8 percent interest. She said she borrowed the money from her campaign after learning that her father would not be able to come to Oregon until January and after she received the letter from Graham.

Jolin said she made sure the

transaction was recorded in her campaign records and insisted that the loan be repaid before the start of the 1991 legislative session Jan. 14.

Jolin was driving the Nissan on May 19 when she was involved in a two-car accident on Interstate 5 near Albany.

Golina that's straight out of *9½ Weeks*. Let's just say the food and sex scene in that movie wasn't nearly as hot as it is here.

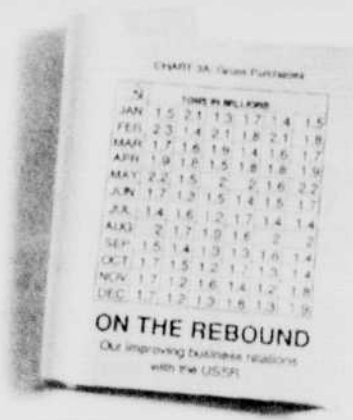

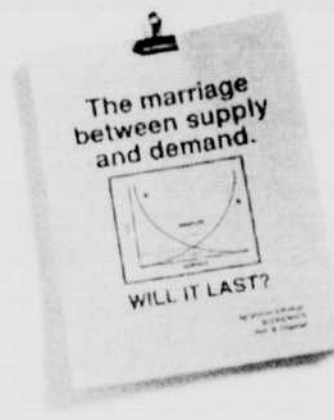

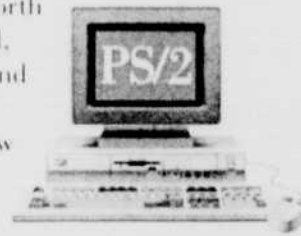
