Censorship on the rise in state

PORTLAND (AP) — Oregon was second only to California in the number of censorship attempts to remove materials from public schools in 1990, a watchdog group says.

But of the 19 attempts to have books pulled from school library shelves in Oregon last year, only one was successful, the People for the American

Way report said.

Michael Hudson, vice president of the organization, said censorship in education is part of a trend throughout the country in which the arts are being challenged by extreme conservatives.

People for the American Way is an organization that opposes challenges it believes threaten

the U.S. Constitution.

Of the 229 incidents of attempted censorship reported in school systems throughout the United States last year, a third were successful, the report said.

"One-third is a very serious figure, especially when you consider these are incidents that were published," Hudson said. "We have no doubt that this is the tip of the iceberg. What's more worrisome is the chilling effect it is having in the schools."

The number of challenges is the largest recorded since the organization began reporting nine years ago.

In Oregon, an elementary reading series called "Impressions" was removed by the North Marion School Board.

Parents complained that the series contained recurring themes of death and brutality.

"Catcher in the Rye" by J.D. Salinger was challenged because of profanity, and two science books, "Sunship Earth" and "The Earth Speaks," were opposed on grounds that they promoted New Age religion and inaccurate science.

Oregon school districts have the authority to use any materials listed by the state textbook commission, said Kathryn Murdock, director of legal services for the state school superintendent's office.

Murdock noted that the Legislature has shifted the responsibility for selecting school materials from the commission to the state superintendent's office, beginning this year.

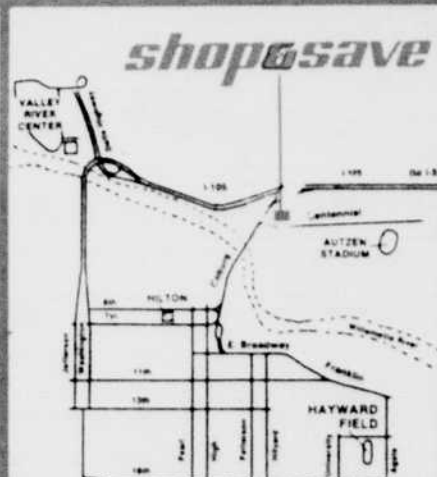
