

Burwell loss bodes ill for Ducks

"We are pretty beat up," Coach Rich Brooks said Wednesday. "We've got some bumps and bruises."



Nonetheless, the anticipated capacity crowd hopes the Ducks will not perform like substitutes.

Most notable of the losses Saturday night may be tailback Sean Burwell. The sophomore led the Pacific-10 Conference in rushing after the Ducks' first two games, but a sprained ankle he suffered in practice prevented him from playing in Oregon's loss at Utah, and will likely keep
