fields.

Development plans call for preservation of one playing field presently on the site.

The research park plan is a "financial boondoggle," Urquhart said.

The University originally planned to have money coming in from tenants by 1985-86. Instead, it has spent millions and has little to show, he said.

"This project has been dead in the water since it started," Urquhart said. "I liken it to the (savings and loan) scandals."

Because the University does not have a separate account for research park expenditures, Wiley said she does not know how much money has been spent to date.

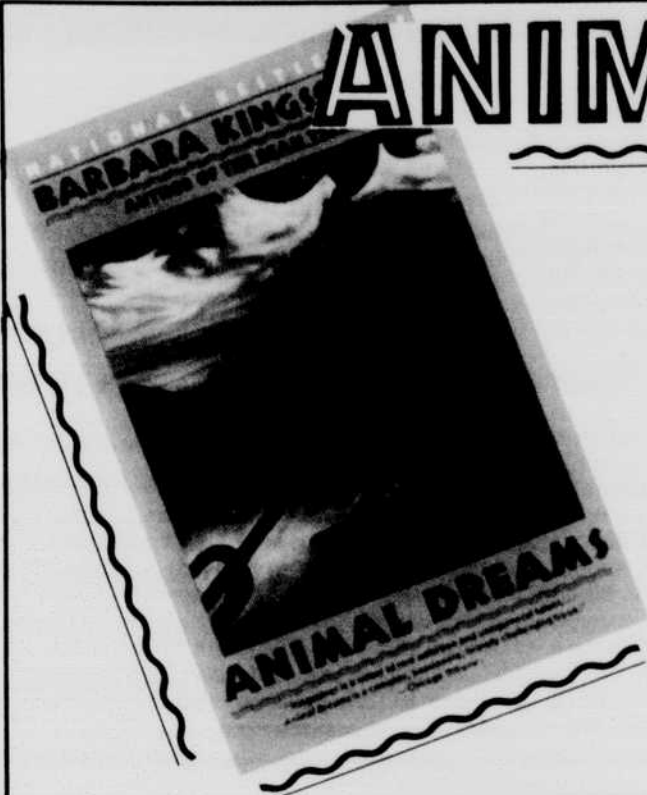

# ANIMAL DREAMS

Barbara Kingsolver's *Animal Dreams* has earned the highest recommendations from those of us in the General Book Dept. (It was my personal favorite from last year). Set in the Southwest of Tony Hilleman, (who calls it, "a beautiful, memorable novel full of scenes and images that linger in the mind."), it tells the story of Codi Nolene and how she finds healing and hope through her connections to the landscape and her rediscovered community.

Dreamless and at the end of her rope after several years of drifting, Codi comes back to Grace, Arizona, to confront her past and face her ailing, distant father. What she finds is a town threatened by a silent environmental catastrophe, some startling clues to her own identity, and a man and a community whose views of the world could change the course of her life.

Blending flashbacks, dreams, and Native American legends, *Animal Dreams* is a suspenseful love story and a moving exploration of life's largest commitments.

"A well-nigh perfect novel," (one critic called it), "brimming with insight, humor and compassion," this is one you'll want to pass around to all your friends.
