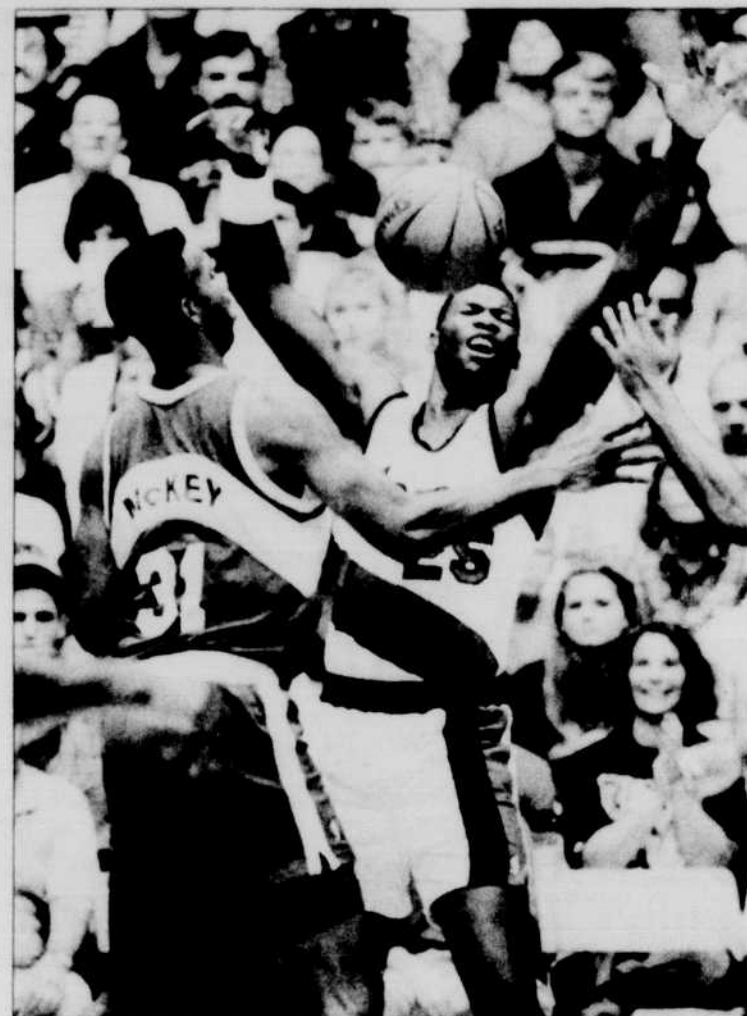
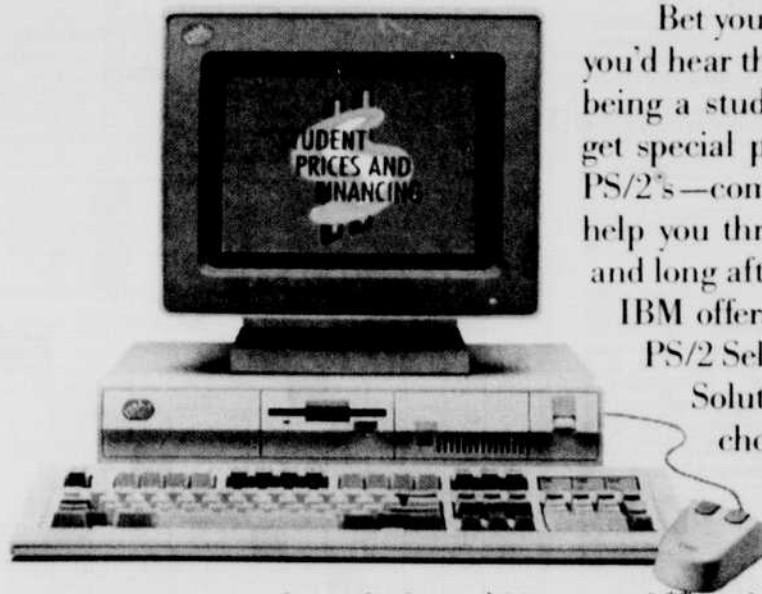

But the pressure to repeat an appearance in the NBA finals last year was much greater than any pressure this season, Cooper said.

"Last year we did experience some pressure," he said. "We are more relaxed. We know what to expect now. This is our third chance, and we realize we've got to do it now."

If Sunday night's game is any indication of what to expect from the Blazers this season, Portland's defense may make

the team even better than last year.

The Blazers gave up no more than 20 points in a quarter to the Sonics, and that came in a mostly garbage-time fourth period.

Derrick McKey was Seattle's leading scorer with 12 points but was the only Sonic in double-figures, and Payton, the No. 2 pick of the 1990 NBA draft, shot 3 of 10 from the floor and had only seven points.

"We're back to business," Portland guard Clyde Drexler said. "When we play that kind of defense, it makes the difference in the game."
