# Men charged for assaulting pair

One man was arrested for assault and another arrested for minor in possession of alcohol by consumption Friday night after two University students were assaulted.

Shawn Robert Holt, 18, of Longview, Wash., is accused of assaulting University students Martin John Passmore, 18, and Anthony Michael Kady, 17, both of the 600 block of East 11th Avenue. Holt was arrested for two counts of assault.

Jason Wendell Voreis, 18, of Glide, Ore., was cited for minor in possession of alcohol by consumption. He was later charged with assault.

Kady and Passmore told police they were walking near the corner of 12th Avenue and Hilyard

Street when they were approached by a group of five to seven young men.

The men in the group reportedly harassed Kady and Passmore, said Tim Birr, Eugene police department spokesman.

Kady told police he and Passmore were then attacked by the group, police said. When police arrived on the scene, Kady and Passmore were being assaulted by two other men who immediately left the scene, police said.

Holt told police the group confronted Kady after they were called skinheads, according to the police report.

Holt and Voreis have been released.
