

# Women need win to regain lost ground in conference

The Oregon volleyball team is 1-8 in the Pacific-10 Conference and in ninth place after the first half of the season, but the Ducks still have a lot at stake this weekend when they face Arizona and Arizona State at McArthur Court.

The main goal is to get a conference win, which would keep Oregon out of the conference cellar. The Ducks have lost six straight conference games, their last win coming three weeks ago at Arizona, which is winless in the conference.

But Oregon coach Gerry Gregory isn't looking past the Wildcats, who have won only three matches the entire season.

"We're going to treat Arizona as if they're the best team in the Pac-10," Gregory said. They've been more competitive in the conference than we have lately. We have absolutely no reason to be overconfident."

Oregon is coming off an embarrassing loss last Friday at Oregon State, in which the Ducks were shut out in a game for the first time in 12 years.

Arizona is coming off two four-game losses last weekend to Washington and Washington State, which is ranked as high as 18th in one national poll.

The Ducks may again be without senior starters Mindee

Adams and Molly McGrath for tonight's match against Arizona and Saturday evening's battle with the Sun Devils. Gregory said neither player is at 100 percent, and both are questionable for the two matches.

Adams has been out since mid-September with a stress fracture of the ankle, and Mc Grath went down three weeks ago with a back injury.

Still, Oregon should have an excellent opportunity to get back into the win column against the Wildcats, who have lost nine straight matches.

"They are an inconsistent passing team," Gregory said. "I thought that was one of the main keys in our win over them. And we also blocked well in that match."

Arizona State, sixth in the Pac-10 with a 4-5 record and 9-7 overall, presents a tougher challenge. The Sun Devils swept Washington last weekend and lost in four games to Washington State.


'Arizona State has a more balanced attack than Arizona," Gregory said. "Their middle attack was pretty effective against us last time, and their serve receiving is one of the best in the
