## Carving Catastrophe

or all those pumpkin-happy students out there who want a new and improved way to carve their orange vegetables, try one of these ideas. How about carving just below the surface, without actually cutting all the way through. "This way, you're designing the face on the skin of the pumpkin, going just below the surface," said Janet Calvert, home economist at the Lane County Extension Service. If that seems a bit too simple, how about using other vegetables and toothpicking them onto the pumpkin surface. Calvert suggested using carrot rounds for eyes and green peppers for ears. Be as creative as you want. After all, carving a pumpkin is part of what Halloween is all about.
