7: Nosferatu - F.W. Murnau's early silent version of the Dracula story is bizarre, scary, atmospheric and hypnotic. This is a silent film that takes full advantage of the lack of dialogue, concentrating on mood and almost perfectly creating its own

6: Psycho - The granddaddy of all slasher flicks. No, really. Take a look at it. The only difference is that modern horror movies that rip it off leave out everything that made it good. There's very little gore here but oodles of suspense and ter-

5: Fright Night - A nifty old-fashioned horror movie about a young man who suspects his next door neighbor of being a vampire. Of course no one believes him and he turns to Roddy McDowell, a Vincent Price type TV horror movie host/actor, to help him keep the block safe. Treated with a good dose of self-efacing humor, this is a model for quality modern horror pictures.

4: Wicker Man - Since Halloween is a pagan holiday, it seems appropriate to include a movie celebrating the joys of paganism. The imaginative story line involves a group of people perfectly happy in their sexually permissive society. Their lives are disrupted by the investigation of a missing girl by a devout Catholic investigator. There's plenty of opportunity to question the truth religion has to offer in this incredibly engrossing film.

3: Silence of the Lambs - The new choice as cinema's most terrifying movie may well be this Jonathan Demme masterpiece. Not only is the suspense created as deftly as has ever been done, but the acting and dialogue between Jodie Foster and the frightening Anthony Hopkins nears perfection. Anyone who says they can't be scared should see

2: Theatre of Blood - Believe it or not, critics are not universally beloved. Vincent Price plays a Shakespearean actor who doesn't handle criticism well.
