Brandon to make NBA debut in Portland

Terrell Brandon will be back in Oregon tonight.

He will not be wearing the green and yellow, though. Instead, the former Oregon star will suit up in a Cleveland Cavaliers uniform for his regular season NBA debut tonight against the Portland Trail Blazers.

Brandon, the 11th pick of the 1991 NBA Draft, is living out his dream, playing his first regular season game in front of what amounts to a hometown crowd. The coincidence is just fine for the Portland native, who starred at Grant High in Portland before coming to play for the Ducks.

"It gives me a chance to play in front of my family and friends," Brandon said by phone from Portland Thursday night. "I'm not nervous at all. I'm real excited."

The Cavaliers wrapped up a successful 6-2 pre-season Monday night with a 127-110 win at Charlotte, and Brandon was impressive enough during the pre-season campaign to earn a start.

Brandon led the team in minutes and assists during the pre-season, averaging 28 minutes and 5.4 assists a game.

His best game of the season came in a win over Utah when the point guard dished out 10 assists, a pre-season high for the Cavaliers, and a personal-high 13 points.

His scoring also helped Cleveland during the pre-season despite a low shooting percentage. Brandon averaged 10.3 points a game but made only 45 percent of his field goals and 68 percent of his free throws.

"I had a good training camp," Brandon said.

He attributed much of his success to his signing earlier than many other first-round picks, saying he had no desire to try and be a "big shot" and hold out for more money.

"It's not about money," Brandon said. "I'm happy where I'm at."

Brandon entered into the NBA draft early last season as he still had one year of college eligibility remaining. As a junior last year, Brandon led the Ducks to a 13-15 overall record and garnered Pacific-10 Conference Player of the Year honors

after leading the league in scoring.

His early move to the NBA angered some Duck fans, but Brandon doesn't feel any anger toward those who disliked his move.

"I appreciate everything they've done for me," Brandon said of the fans. "I haven't forgotten them."
