

Ducks destroyed by Oregon offense

Oregon's 33-13 homecoming loss Saturday to the Stanford Cardinal featured both major successes and major failures for the Ducks.

Unfortunately, the successes came too often on the defensive side of the football, and the failures too often on the offensive side.

Oregon held Stanford to only 265 yards of total offense after the Cardinal came in averaging more than 400.

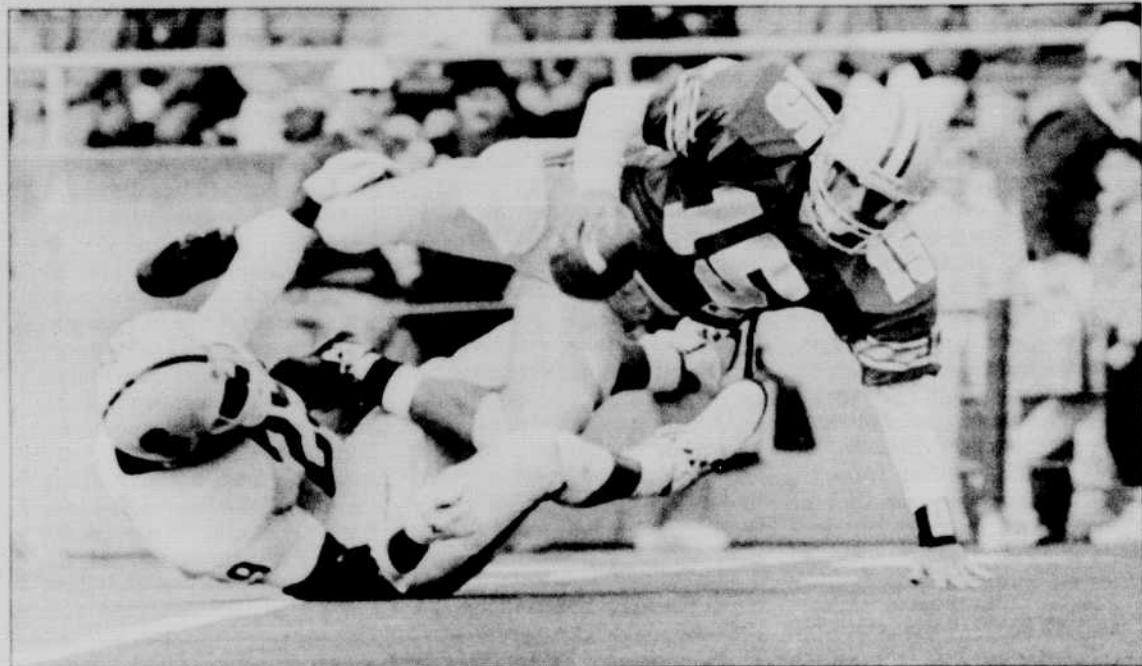
But the Ducks could manage only 192 yards themselves, including a dismal 47 yards not rushing on 36 carries.

And for the third straight game, Oregon's only touchdown — a 14-yard strike from Bob Brothers, the fifth Duck quarterback to see action this season, to Brian Brown — came well after the final outcome had been decided.

But the Oregon offense certainly had good opportunities to put points on the board, especially in the first half.

The Ducks' first two possessions started inside the Stanford 45, but Oregon didn't score a point on either series.

In the first three quarters, Oregon had four drives start in-

Ducks' 33-13 loss to Stanford confirmation of a miserable season

Oregon's 33-13 loss to Stanford on Saturday was nothing more than a confirmation of the miserable season the Ducks are having.

The Ducks slipped to 3-5 on the season in front of 41,949 fans at Autzen Stadium in the homecoming game.

After an impressive defensive showing last weekend at Washington, and with the return of defensive linemen Marcus Woods and Matt LaBounty from the injured list, it looked as though the Ducks would have a chance to get back on the winning trail.

However, it is hard to win games without scoring, and Oregon seemed

unwilling — or maybe unable — to put points on the board.

The Ducks started their first two drives of both halves in Stanford territory but could only accumulate three points.

Coach Rich Brooks was not pleased with his team's performance.

"Our execution fell far short of what we needed to win," he said. "We're struggling on offense. We need to try and get an offense."

Oregon could do nothing right on offense, especially in the first quarter.

The Ducks had the ball four times in the quarter. The first three series went three downs and a punt, and their fourth possession ended when quarterback Kyle Crowston was called for in-

tentional grounding in the end zone resulting in a Cardinal safety.

Oregon's first series of the second quarter ended when Ronnie Harris fumbled on his own 19-yard line. It was not until five minutes in the second quarter that the Ducks finally got a first down.

Despite the extremely dismal first half, the Ducks only trailed 12-3 going into the locker room.

Gregg McCallum's 27-yard field goal midway through the third quarter pulled Oregon within six, but the Ducks would get no closer.

Stanford retaliated three plays later when quarterback Steve Stenstrom hit Jon Pinckney for a 46-yard touchdown pass.

For the next fifteen minutes it looked

as if Autzen Stadium should have had a tent over it because the Ducks looked like a circus.

First, Crowston fumbled a snap and on the following play, made an ill-advised pitchout to tailback Sean Burwell that landed about five yards behind the tailback. Stanford recovered the fumble at the Oregon nine-yard line and scored five plays later when Tommy Vardell scored a touchdown from a yard out.

"I felt our defensive effort was good enough to keep us in the game, but when they broke the long touchdown and then we made a bad pitch instead of eating the ball. ... We just can't do that," Brooks said. "We don't have the offensive fire power to overcome those mistakes."
