Holiday Market Sparkles at the Fairground

Four Weekends of Celebration Begin Friday after Thanksgiving Last Minute Monday December 23rd Added

On Friday, November 29th, Eugene's popular Saturday Market makes its yearly move indoors to the Lane County Fairgrounds where it presents its annual **Holiday Market**, four weekends of outstanding entertainment, a world famous international food court, and thousands of gifts handmade by local artisans.

This year market-goers will find a new Farmer's Market area where local growers will be selling mid-winter produce and dried flowers. A last minute shopping day on Monday, December 23rd from 10 am to 6 pm has been added to the schedule. Special performances for young people, gift wrapping and a massage area for weary shoppers are just some of the services that await Holiday Market visitors.

Founded in 1979 by local artist Lotte Streisinger, Saturday Market is currently the oldest continuously operating open-air craft marketplace in the United States. Several years ago, after more than a decade of shivering in the cold, wet winters on the downtown Park Blocks, Market crafters moved inside to the Lane County Fairgrounds on Thanksgiving weekend and the event has grown in popularity every year since.

Saturday Market is a non-profit organization. Its goal is to provide an affordable marketplace for local artisans and affordable handcrafted products for the citizens of Lane County.

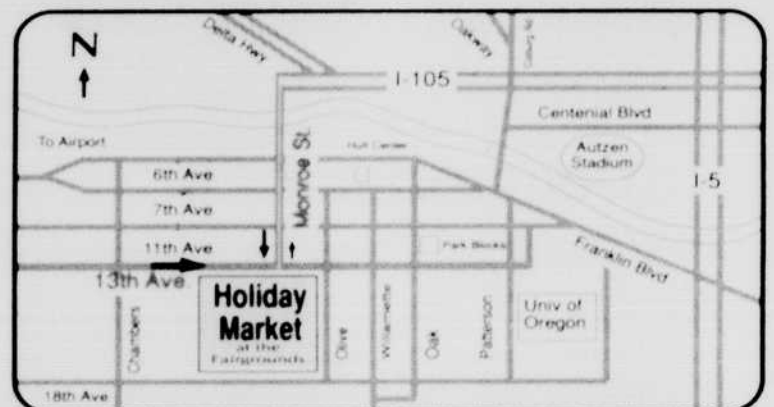
