we were just too passive," he said. "We played as if we were scared."

The Ducks had reason to be scared the following night as they were overwhelmed by LaSalle 105-75 in the third-place game of the tournament.

LaSalle guard Randy Woods and forward Jack Hurd combined for 65 points on 21 of 35 shooting, which included 16 of 23 shots made from three-point land. Hurd alone hit 8 of 9 shots from behind the line.

The Ducks were never in this one as the Explorers jumped out to a quick 23-8 lead and did not look back.

The biggest concern of the game for the Ducks was the loss of Collier for the season with a broken foot. In addition, Lyden will be out of the season for four to six weeks with a foot ligament injury suffered in Saturday's game against Missouri.

Stoudamire was the only Duck to score in double figures as he finished with 26 points

on 8 of 21 shooting from the field.

Oregon State won the tournament by defeating Minnesota in the title game 92-80. The night before the Beavers came back from an 11-point deficit at half-time to defeat LaSalle. It was the 19th time in 35 years the Beavers have claimed the tournament title.

The resurrected and revamped tournament was a disappointment as far as attendance was concerned. The tourney drew less than 14,000 for both nights and less than 7,000 on the final night.

The former eight-team tournament was abandoned by sponsor Fred Meyer two years ago. Thriftway Stores gave the slimmed-down tournament new life after a one-year absence.

Oregon State guard Charles McKinney was named outstanding player of the tournament and was joined on the all-tourney team by teammate Chad Scott, LaSalle's Woods and Hurd, and Minnesota's Carter.

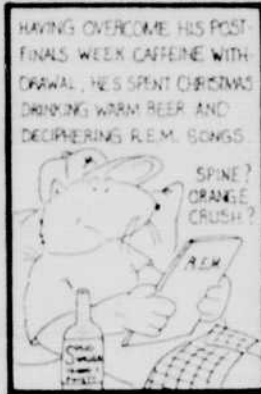
