

Volleyballers net team awards

Senior Dawnn Charroin was named Most Valuable Player for the 1991 Oregon volleyball team, highlighting Sunday's awards banquet.

The 6-foot-1 outside hitter paced the Ducks with 373 kills, 357 digs and 124 blocks and finished her career fourth on Oregon's all-time kill list with 1,283.

Charroin also tied freshman Kalle Kerr for the Mental Toughness/Extra Effort Award. It was the third-

straight year that Charroin had either won or shared the honor.

Kerr started the last part of the season when senior Molly McGrath was injured, and Kerr averaged 5.2 assists and 1.6 digs for the season as a setter.

Stephanie Warren was named Rookie of the Year after collecting 243 kills and 70 blocks as a middle blocker.

Freshman La Reina Woods of Corvallis picked up the

Chris Voelz Positive Mental Attitude Award.

Also picking up awards were Eugene sophomore outside hitter Nicolle Hedberg as the most improved player, senior middle blocker Mindee Adams for community service and sportsmanship (the Esper Ritchey Award) and junior middle blocker Marcie Price as the Harry Ritchey Scholar-Athlete Award winner.

Club Sports ranger team bumps Portland, takes title

The Oregon Club Sports ranger challenge team won the state title Dec. 14 in the Portland State Invitational at Camp Bonneville, Wash.

The Ducks edged Portland State for the state crown, and the Oregon second team finished third overall out of a seven-team field.

The competition consisted of five events: the Army Physical Fitness Test, team orienteering, weapons assembly, rope bridge construction and a 10-kilome-

ter run with rucksacks.

An Oregon team average of 296 (out of 300) on the APFT was good enough for first place in that event, and the Ducks grabbed an early lead. The PSU Vikings overtook the Ducks by winning orienteering, but Oregon tied the score by capturing weapons assembly.

Portland State's rope bridge time of 1:50 — one second faster than Oregon — gave the Vikings a one-point lead going into the 10K run. The Duck first team led the race from the beginning, finishing in 56:16, nearly 15 minutes ahead of second-place Portland State.

Other schools in the competition were Western Oregon, Oregon State, Montana and Central Washington.

The Ducks and Vikings will represent the state at the Brigade Ranger Challenge Competition at Fort Lewis, Wash. Feb. 14-16.

In other Oregon Club Sports news:

- The Club Sports ski team travels to a racing competition Jan. 18-19 at Mount Bachelor. The meet, sponsored by Central Oregon Community College, will be all day Saturday and Sunday.

In future meets, Oregon competes at Willamette Pass Jan. 25-26 and at Anthony Lakes Feb. 1-2.

- The Club Sports coed indoor soccer team won the first of eight tournament games, 3-1, against Portland city league teams.

The Ducks travel to Portland once a week for the games.

Oregon is gearing up for a home indoor tournament Feb. 21-23 against northwest collegiate teams.
