## 'Freejack' revisits the land of 'Total Recall'

 FILM *Freejack* is now showing at Movies 12 and MovieLand.



The first ridiculous premise that this film expects the viewer to swallow is that the human race has mastered time travel. So you can see how this review will go, but we must persevere.

Emilio Estevez plays Alex Furlong, a race car driver who is chosen by a wealthy industrialist to be the rich man's new body. (Oh, yeah, by the year 2009, technology has also advanced to the point that minds can be electronically transferred from one body to another.)

Furlong is thrown into the future at precisely the point before he dies; a victim of a freak accident on the track. Once he arrives, he is surrounded by a bunch of medical-type guys in aluminum-foil outfits who proceed to wrap him in Saran Wrap. We're talking high-tech special effects here, folks.

Naturally, he escapes. Escaping is the one thing this guy can do well. It seems apparent that many people whose bodies are hijacked from the past are able to escape since there's a specific name for these fugitives. Naturally, they are called freejacks.

Mick Jagger, after a 20-year absence from acting, inexplicably chose this script to make his cinematic return. He can be a fine actor, but here he mostly overacts. In this case, it doesn't really work against the film, since most of the characters are far less interesting than the chase scenes.

Jagger plays Vacendak, sup-

posedly one of the best bounty hunters around. You could have fooled me.

Here's Furlong, who's completely out of his element, on the run from people he doesn't know, with a price on his head. He has no resources or friends to turn to, yet he is constantly out-manuevering the best bounty hunter money can buy. I think not.

If this sounds a tad bit like *Total Recall*, then I'm not giving a good description of it. It's a whole lot like *Total Recall*—without decent special effects.

This is one of those visions of the future where the filmmakers think they're being revolutionary by having the set designer freely mix cars from the '50s into the slum areas.

With this movie, you can play a rousing game of Spot the Plot Holes. Why, for instance, does Furlong survive in the seedy dive for so long? These people are poor, and there's a big price on his head, yet they treat him like a hero.

Anthony Hopkins is featured in a small and thankless role as the man who contracts for Furlong's body. Hopefully, after his success in *Silence of the Lambs*, his talents won't be wasted on such mindless pap.

There is one scene near the end of the movie that is a screen-filling, hallucinatory bonanza. It's something that certainly won't be worth watching on video, but I can't recommend the movie either.

My best suggestion is that you pay for a better movie and sneak into this one for the last 15 minutes. After all, that's the only thing multiplexes are good for.
