Although the theme centered around hearts, the children didn't limit their imagina-

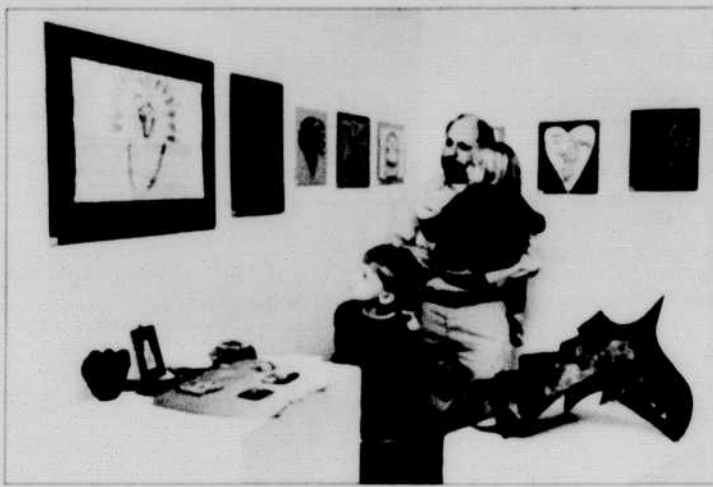

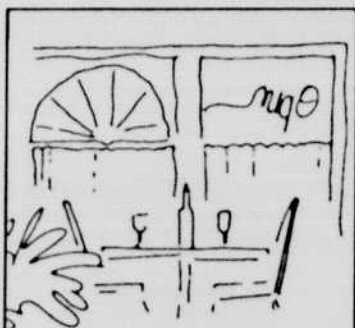

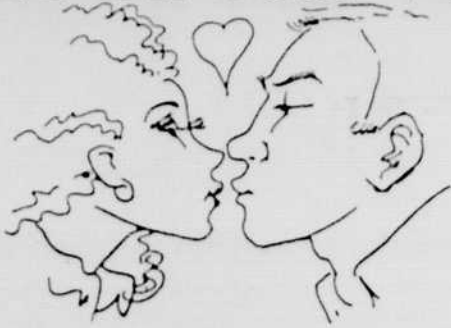
