shooter."

That's an understatement from Harrick, whose Bruins improved to 19-1 overall and 10-1 in the Pac-10. The win gave UCLA sole possession of first place in the conference after USC lost Saturday at Oregon State.

Murray said the announcement of

USC's loss, which came before the Bruins and Ducks took the floor, helped motivate his team.

"It added a little fuel to the fire," Murray said. "We were already ready to play, but that just made us more ready."

Oregon actually shot 50 percent for the game on 26 of 52, but the Ducks made a lot of shots after the game had been decided.

And UCLA's defense did what it had

to do, namely shutting down Oregon's leading scorer, Antoine Stoudamire.

Stoudamire, who had 34 and 32 points in his previous two games, scored just six in the first half and finished with 17 on 7 of 19 shooting.

Monson didn't comment on Saturday's Associated Press article in which Oregon athletic director Bill Byrne expressed disappointment with the Ducks' lack of success this season.

Byrne also said in the article that he will decide at the end of this season whether or not to keep Monson at Oregon. Monson, who is 116-137 in his ninth year as the Ducks' head coach, has two years remaining on his contract.

The Ducks will travel north this week for a Thursday game against Washington and a Saturday night contest at Washington State.
