OREGON STATE: Oregon State is often thought of as the doormat of the Pac-10 in most sports, but not in wrestling. The Beavers are the most improved team in the Pac-10, having gone from seventh in the conference tournament last year to conference dual meet champions this year.

The Beavers, ranked 16th in the country, had a perfect 7-0 conference record, including a home and away sweep of the Ducks. The Beavers traveled to Arizona State for a tournament earlier this seacores were kept.

"We started a rebuilding process two years ago," Beaver coach Mark Johnson said, "and the kids clude former NCAA qualifier Darhave improved faster than anyone thought possible."

The "kids" Johnson will count on include Babak Mohammadi, a sixth-place finisher at the NCAA tournament last year at 126 pounds, and Matt Willhite, the 1990 Pac-10 heavyweight champion. Other top wrestlers for Oregon State will be Ryan Sugai, a transfer from Iowa, and Dan Alar, ranked 7th in the nation at 158 pounds.




