Pay by April 1 to avoid fee

Due to a scheduling conflict, the University Business Office cashier and financial aid check disbursement operations will be in the EMU Ballroom only on Monday, March 30; Tuesday, March 31; and Wednesday, April 1. After that date, students may go to the Business Office, first floor of Oregon Hall, to pay or receive money regarding registration.

All students are encouraged to use the drop box in front of Oregon Hall or to mail in payments, by check, whenever possible. Tuition payments must be received by Wednesday, April 1 to avoid a \$50 late registration fee.

Nominations sought for GTF awards

Two \$500 awards for distinguished teaching by Graduate Teaching Fellows will be presented at the Spring Commencement, June 14, 1992. These awards have been established by the University in cooperation with the Mortar Board hon-

or society. This is the 13th year the awards are being presented.

The objective is to give recognition for excellence in teaching and academic guidance. All Graduate Teaching Fellows involved in classroom or laboratory teaching are eligible for nomination by students (graduate and undergraduate) and faculty.

A selection committee made up of students and faculty is now seeking nominations. These nominations must be in writing, and should indicate the reasons that the nominee is outstanding. An individual may nominate more than one GTF. All nominations must include a signature. Previous recipients are not eligible for consideration in subsequent years.

Forms may be picked up at departmental offices, the Knight Library reference desk area, or the reference desk area of the Science Library.

All nominations should be sent to the Graduate School, 125 Chapman Hall, no later than Friday, April 17, 1992.

ASUO representative Priscilla Warren were opposed.

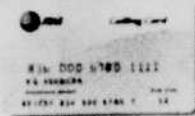
Dunlap added an amendment that a committee be formed to include budget committee Chairman Green and IFC Chairwoman Lydia Lerma, that will look into other possibilities for restructuring the budget.

The budget now goes before the entire EMU Board of Directors and, if it passes, will be presented to the IFC on April 7 in one lump sum. IFC members cannot change line items, but can continue to reject the budget until one is presented that meets their demands.

Lerma, who has been at the heart of the protests and was involved in drawing up the IFC's proposal for the EMU budget, said she will vote in opposition if the budget that passed Friday comes before the IFC.
