## Filing deadline for elections nearing

Students interested in an elected position in student government next year have until Monday at 5 p.m. to officially declare their intent and be included on the ballots later this month.

Election packets and filing information are available in the ASUO office in EMU Suite 4.

In addition to choosing a new ASUO president and vice president, students will elect six Incidental Fee Committee members (two two-year seats and four one-year seats), two EMU Board members (both two-year seats), two members of the Associated Students President's Advisory Council (both oneyear seats) and 15 student sena-

Primary elections will be held April 22 and 23 and general elections, including ballot measures and any run-offs, will be held April 29 and 30. If one of the tickets for president and vice president wins more than 50 percent of the vote during

the primary, that ticket automatically wins the election.

All ballot measures must be approved by the Constitution Court and turned in to the ASUO by 5 p.m. April 10.

The first debate among candidates for president and vice president is set for April 15. Bobby Lee and Karmen Fore, Chris Pharis and Donald Morgan, and Don King and Holly Ferguson are the three tickets who have already announced their candidacy
