'Let's see some I.D.'

PORTLAND (AP) — Beginning July 1, bartenders and liquor servers must check the identification of any customer who appears to be under 26 years old, the Oregon Liquor Control Commission decided.

"Teen-age drinking is a very serious problem," OLCC assistant administrator Mike Reed said in announcing the rule change. "The amendment should make it much harder for minors to buy alcohol."

Husband sentenced for igniting wife

ALBANY (AP) — A man convicted of setting his wife on fire in an attempt to kill her has been sentenced to 38 years in prison.

Linn County Circuit Judge Jackson Frost assessed the term Monday against Freddy Leon Wildman.

Wildman, 46, was convicted in December of a May 1, 1991, attack on Faye Wildman, 58, at her

rural Lebanon home.

Faye Wildman testified that he threw her to the ground, grabbed a jug of gasoline, splashed it over her and ignited it with his cigarette lighter.

Portland college losing accreditation

PORTLAND (AP) — Columbia Christian College, which has operated in Portland since 1956, will lose its accreditation July 1 because of financial problems, college officials say.

However, they hope to keep the institution in full operation and to regain accreditation in 1993.

The decision to withdraw the college's accreditation was made in December after financial instability began to erode the quality of several academic programs, Joe Malik said. Malik is executive director of the Commission on Colleges of the Seattle-based Northwest Association of Schools and Colleges.

Free said Columbia Christian has about 270 students this spring.

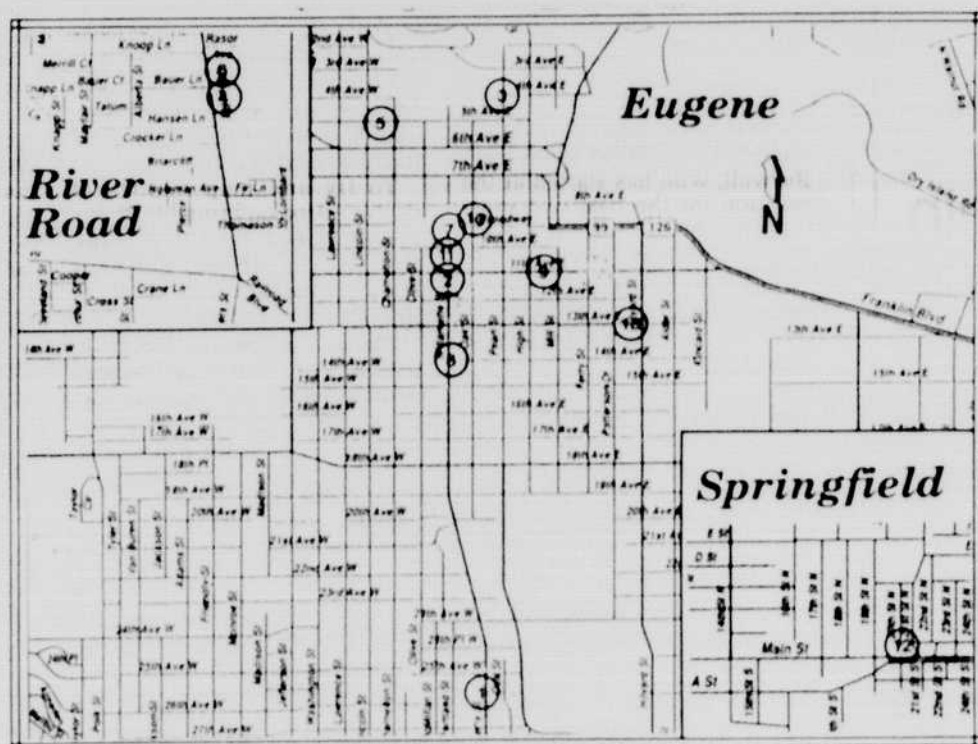
