## Little Women gears up for live recording party

Scream yourself hoarse.  
Dance yourself dead tired.  
This will be a live album recording and all of Eugene is invited.

Little Women, the Colorado-turned-Portland band, wants to pack WOW Hall, 291 W. Eighth Ave., on Saturday night at 9 p.m. — so much so that they're charging only \$4 for advance tickets.

How do you make a live recording? The microphones on the band's instruments that carry sound to the PA system will also carry the music to a truck outside the building for recording.

Could something go wrong? "The recording will only be messed up if the band plays badly, if a cable goes out or a mike goes dead," said Scott McLoud, WOW Hall's stage manager.

Could the audience be too rowdy? "You can't scream loud enough," he said.

Originally a reggae-oriented band, Little Women's style has been described as a mix of Southern boogie, calypso, surf rock, Cajun and mainstream "power pop" rhythms.

Jerry Joseph, lead vocalist/guitarist/main songwriter, said the band's current style is just hard to describe.

While Little Women's first two albums, the critically acclaimed 1987 *Life's Just Bitchin'* and 1989 *Pretty Wiped Out* were studio recorded; this third album will be recorded live for the band's long-time fans.

"We're going to try to represent all the different phases we've done through the past 10 years," Joseph said. This means 30 different songs, including reggae from *Life's Just Bitchin'* and many songs written and played live over the past two years — songs that were never released.

Thirty different songs equals two-plus hours of music. That's
