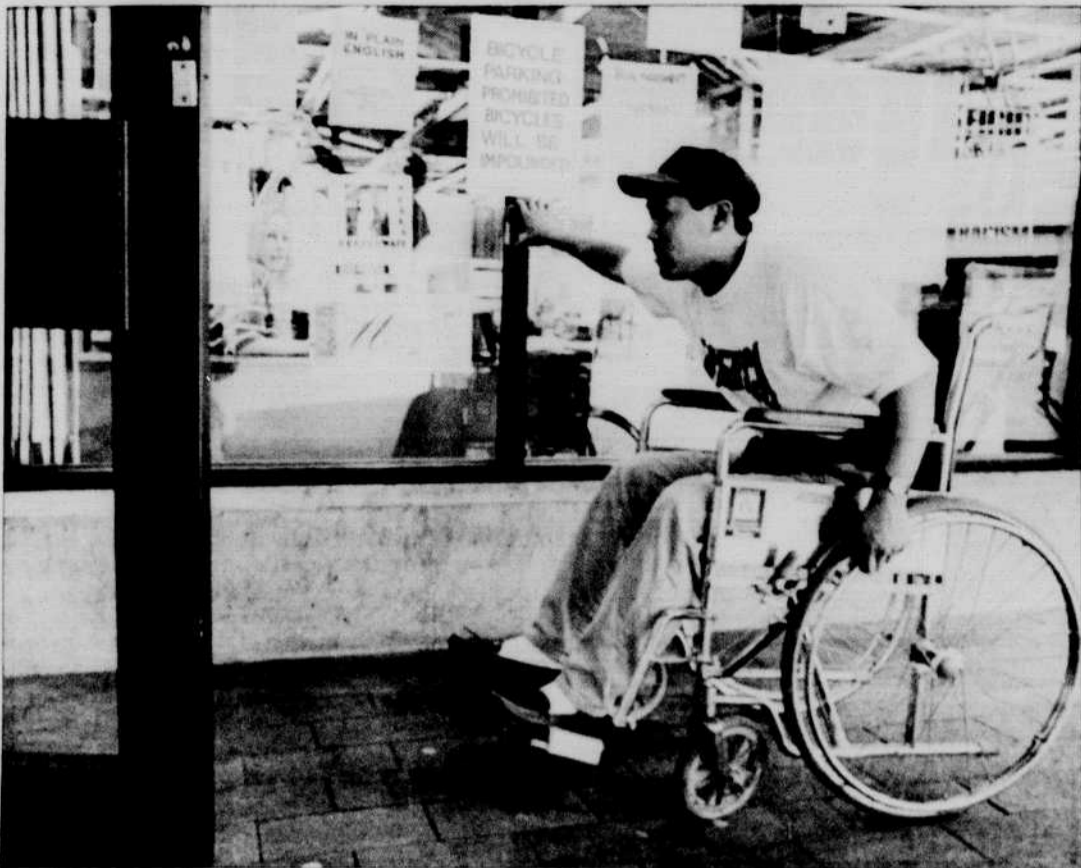

POLICE BEAT

The following incidents were reported to the Office of Public Safety and the Eugene police department March 30 to April 6.

• Police arrested two transients for robbing a man on March 31 of three cans worth 15 cents in return value, according to police reports.

A 33-year-old man who collects bottles and cans for a living said he was walking his bike in the east/west alley between Hilyard and Patterson streets and 14th and 15th avenues when two men approached him, according to police.

As the two men approached the victim, he asked, "Can I help you with something?" according to police.

The men both said, "The tax man is here to col-

lect" and looked at the empty bottles in the carts behind the man's bike.

The victim said he thought the men were going to take his bottles and cans, according to police. He said he was afraid he was going to be assaulted and felt threatened. He tried to continue walking and ignore the two men. The 36-year old suspect then stepped in front of the victim and held his front bike tire between his legs making it impossible for him to leave.
