Chris Pharis and Donald Morgan, candidates for ASUO president and vice president, say they entered the race to make a running commentary on the state of student government, but they wouldn't be disappointed if they won.

"We're not in it to win," Morgan said. "We want to raise the amount of political awareness in the student body."

Pharis said, "We're not against winning, but we feel that winning is not victory. Vic-

tory for us is raising awareness — bringing our message to the people."

So what exactly is that message? Remember that Pharis and Morgan are the candidates who want to counter the effects of Measure 5 by building a roller coaster in Willamette Hall and charging admission, and creating the first underwater University and charging people

"Our message is the message of power for lower level, basic level students like ourselves," Pharis said.

Morgan said the first thing on the agenda if they win is an enormous victory party with everyone invited. Secondly, Pharis said plenty of reforms are on tap.


"We'd have lots of reforms — reforms in general, across-the-board reforms," Pharis said. "Of course, if it doesn't need reforming, we'll leave it alone. But we feel that a lot of the ASUO needs to go through some serious reforms. The way we'll gauge what needs to be reformed, is that anyone who gives us trouble, we'll reform them on the spot."

Multiculturalism is a perennial buzzword among candidates, and Pharis and Morgan have their own ideas about how to improve it on campus.

They said they plan to send people on trips around the world for the summer to visit other cultures.

"Because Chris and I have a lot of connections in the federal government, going all the way


