back coming in, made this most evident. The junior hit on only three of his eight passes for 25 yards with the White team, but he rebounded to connect on five of six for 75 yards while in a Green jersey.

Sophomore Kyle Crowston was four of six for 71 yards and redshirt freshman Clayton Millis three of five for 55 yards and one interception.

Despite having the lowest numbers, Millis made an impression on Brooks when he picked up a safety blitz and hit tight end O.B. Babbs for a 40-yard gain.

"Millis showed some poise for a redshirt freshman," Brooks said. "He hasn't been getting the reps that the others have this spring, but he seized an opportunity today."

It was the Green team making the most of opportunities provided by the bumbling play of the White.

The White team fumbled on its first possession, setting up a quick Green score. When the White got the ball back, the first-team defense forced a punt after three plays.

Punter Tommy Thompson sent the first of his booming kicks 52 yards into the end zone, setting up a one-play 80-yard drive for the Green.

Tailback Donovan Moore took the handoff from O'Neil, sprinted through a gaping hole, bounced a would-be tackler and found the hash-mark lane on the sideline for the final 50 yards of his 80-yard dash that built the Green lead to 14-0.

The game ended on defensive end Jeff Cummins' 51-yard interception return for a touchdown.

ils didn't waste any time jumping on Oregon pitcher Amy Godwin, who just a day earlier had held second-ranked Arizona to just three hits and one unearned run in a 1-0 loss.

Natasha Dumoski replaced Godwin in the second inning and held the Sun Devils to a single run in the sixth inning. Fleischauer singled again to start the bottom of the seventh, but Oregon couldn't take advantage.

"I wasn't pleased at all with our offense in the second

game," Brown said. "We popped up balls that shouldn't have been popped up and wasted too many scoring chances."

Manning tied her own single season school record with her sixth home run in Friday's first game against Stanford (0-37), and Marnie McCall — who broke her left hand a week ago against UCLA — went 2 for 3.

The Ducks close out their season at home this weekend, starting with a 2:30 double-header Friday against Sacramento State and finishing with a 1:00 twinbill Saturday against fourth-ranked California.

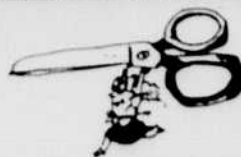
