ering it was the fourth event of the day for Gray.

Earlier in the day, Gray defeated MacDonald in the 110 hurdles, and ran a leg in both the 4X100 and 4X400 relays. The Ducks won both events.

Oregon never led in the meet, thanks to the lack of a hammer thrower. Washington State took all three places in the hammer throw to take a 9-0 lead after only one event.

"We conceded nine points," Dellinger said. "and then we started the meet."

Among the other top performances for the Ducks was Tye Van Schoiack's victory in the steeplechase, which qualified him for the NCAA Championships.

Van Schoiack said he had a lot of confidence coming into the meet.

"I was questioning last night if I was being too confident, saying I was going to qualify (for the NCAAs)," he said.

Dellinger said he was happy with his team in spite of the loss.

"I'm real proud of the way we competed today," Dellinger said.
