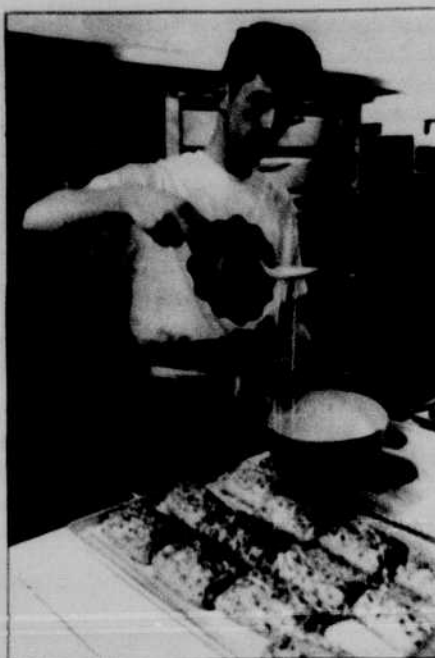


A DAY IN THE LIFE
