South African government nearing disaster, Tutu says

NESBURG. South Africa (AP) - Archbishop Desmond

Tutu threatened Monday to press for South Africa's expulsion from the Olympics, and President F.W. de Klerk cut short a visit to Spain to deal with the country's political cri-

The African National Congress canceled scheduled talks on ending apartheid. But it said it would decide Tuesday whether to resume the negotiations with the government and other political groups or intensify a campaign of protest.

Our country is on the brink of disaster," Anglican Archbishop Tutu said, at a prayer service in Cape Town for the 42 victims of last Wednesday's massacre at the black township of Boipatong, south of Johannesburg.

The massacre has exacerbated a crisis of confidence between the ANC, South Africa's largest black political group. and the government.

Survivors claim police provided transportation for the attackers, allegedly Zulu hostel dwellers who support the Inkatha Freedom Party, the ANC's main rival.

The government denies involvement.

On Monday, police announced the arrests of five workers from the hostel, but said no charges had been filed.

Tutu said that unless the government moved swiftly to punish those responsible, he would press for South Africa to be expelled from next month's Olympic Games - its first Olympics after being banned for 32 years.

Tutu called on de Klerk to permit an international monitoring force to patrol black townships and to put government security forces under control of all political groups, not just the government.

"This is his last chance," said the clergyman, who won the 1984 Nobel Peace Prize for his anti-apartheid efforts.

Amid rising black anger, ANC leader Nelson Mandela on Sunday suspended a planned meeting with the government. On Monday, the ANC also canceled a meeting Tuesday with 18 other groups. No new date

If the ANC opts to stay out of negotiations there is virtually

no hope of resolving the country's political conflict.

Mandela on Monday telephoned Secretary-General Boutros Boutros-Ghali and appealed for his mediation in the deteriorating situation, U.N. officials said.

De Klerk was cutting short a visit to Spain to try to salvage his relations with the ANC and keep negotiations from falling

He was expected to return after a meeting Tuesday with

Prime Minister Felipe Gonzalez, cancelling a visit Wednes-day to Expo '92, the Spanish state news agency EFE report-

According to EFE, de Klerk was in the Mediterranean resort town of Mijas on Monday. The South African embassy in Spain said he was "on a private visit and does not want to be bothered by anybody."

Mandela has insisted that only peaceful negotiations can give South Africa a multiracial government, but he cannot ignore the anger of his constitutents.

While he has been talking with de Klerk's government, violence in the townships has claimed thousands of lives and black poverty has worsened as a result of a three-year-old re-
