# OCA convinced to delay third-party bid

SALEM (AP) — Former U.S. Rep. Denny Smith persuaded the Oregon Citizens Alliance on Monday to delay a third-party bid against Republican Sen. Bob Packwood.

The OCA still plans to file papers with the state to create a new political party to represent conservatives. But Chairman Lon Mabon said the party would reconsider whether to run Al Mobley for U.S. Senate.

Packwood already faces a tough general election challenge from Democratic U.S. Rep. Les AuCoin. The prospect of Mobley playing a possible spoiler's role has alarmed Packwood's supporters.

Mabon said Smith called him

Monday morning and offered to try to mediate the dispute between the OCA and moderate Republicans who run the state GOP.

Mabon said he wasn't sure what Smith could do to heal the rift, which grew even wider during the Republican Party's state convention in Eugene over the weekend.

"Denny has a lot of integrity," Mabon said. "On that basis, I personally couldn't refuse him the opportunity."

Smith declined to say what he would do to try to bring the warring factions together.

"We'll just have to wait and see how it unfolds," Smith said.
