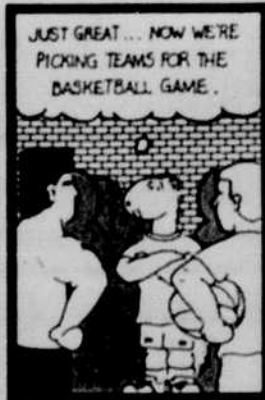

Ducks lose recruit to academic problems

Damion Porter has not met NCAA regulations for transfer to the University this fall and will not join the Ducks' basketball program, Coach Jerry Green announced Friday.

The 6-1, 270-pound center from Rend Lake (Ill.) Community College was Oregon's lone signee for the 1992-93 season. Porter was signed last November during the tenure of former coach Don Monson.

"It's unfortunate he did not elect to attend summer school, knowing he needed to graduate from Rend Lake to be eligible

here," said Green in a press release. "We had been in constant contact with him. We wish him the best of luck in his endeavors."

Green added that it will affect the team this year.

"He would have filled one of the areas we need to strengthen, which is the post position," Green said. "In the long run, it gives us another scholarship. We have no plans to fill the scholarship now, but will use it for a rising high school senior who can help us a year from now."

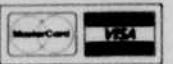
