Court rejects beach access case

SALEM (AP) - A legal challenge to Oregon's law giving the public access to all beaches was rejected Wednesday by the

state Court of Appeals.
Irving "Bud" Stevens of Cannon Beach wants to build a motel on a stretch of beach he

But state and local officials rejected his request to put up a seawall for the project because it would have closed public access to the beach in violation of the 1967 Oregon Beach Bill.


Stevens sued, arguing that government had deprived him of his property rights and that he was owed compensation.


In rejecting his lawsuit, the Court of Appeals said the public's right of access takes precedence over the rights of owners

of beachfront property.
Stevens said he plans to appeal the case to the Oregon Supreme Court.
