Negotiations may resume with S.A. government

JOHANNESBURG, South Africa (AP) — A radical black group said Monday it would meet with the government to discuss terms for returning to talks on ending white minority rule.

The Pan Africanist Congress, a black nationalist group, said it would meet with senior government officials Tuesday to push for a constitution that would be written by a democratically elected assembly.

The Pan Africanist announcement comes amid signs the government and the African National Congress may resume negotiations. The ANC, the largest black opposition group, pulled out of talks in June to protest violence in black town-

ships.

The Pan Africanist Congress, an ideological rival of the ANC, has strong support in some sections of the black community. Its return to the negotiating table would boost chances of a comprehensive settlement between the government and opposition groups.

ANC President Nelson Mandela said he was in telephone contact with President F.W. de Klerk over the weekend.
