lems is the Affirmative Action program, which handles discrimination and sexual harassment issues.

The Ombud Office, one closely connected with the president's office, also handles harassment issues and advocates for fairness within the institution.

The solution in a harassment case can be an academic one, which is designed so that the person's problem does not affect his or her academic success.

Or a solution might be, for example, to have another professor, other than the one in question, grade that person's work. If that isn't effective, another solution, like a legal one involving financial compensation, might be found.

• International students often have special problems when it comes to harassment issues.

Ginny Stark, from the international services office, said that sometimes other cultures do not handle the issue of harassment the way it is handled in the United States.

For example, she said that catcalls and whistling, while they might be accepted in other countries, are not as acceptable in the United States.

"Teachers may be beyond reproach and highly esteemed," Drescher said, citing another possible cultural difference.

She said that this often leads students to believe that they cannot question the appropriateness of teachers' behaviors.

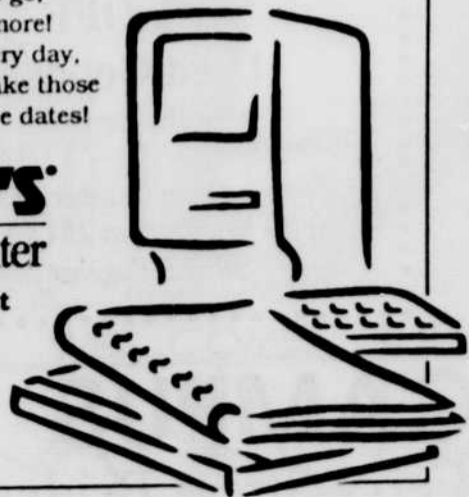

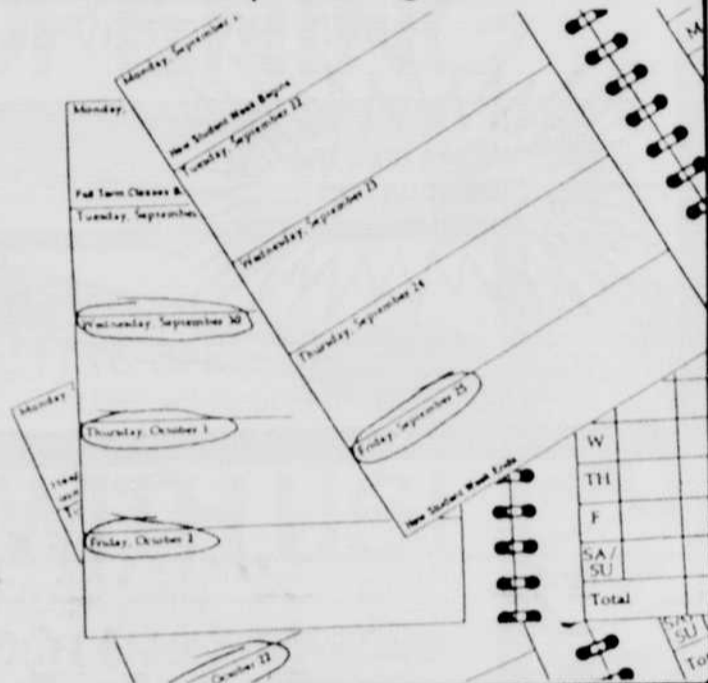
