likes her and she's very competitive."

With a team that includes five freshman and four sophomores, and lost all-conference performer Dawnn Charroin, Conway will be looked upon to fill at least some of the void left by Charroin.

"Anne does a lot of things similar to what Dawnn did," Gregory said. "It's natural for the young players to look to her for experience and leadership."

Despite the obvious high expectations and comparisons to Charroin, Conway said that she hasn't felt any pressure.

"All the pressure I'm feeling is from myself," she said. "I know Gerry expects me to play well, but I haven't felt any pressure from him or the team."

This summer was not the first time Conway had visited the University. She was recruited heavily by Oregon out of high school. Ultimately, she

narrowed her choices down to Illinois and Oregon.

At Illinois, Conway was used to playing for a team that was consistently in the top 20 and at the top of the Big Ten Conference every year. At Oregon, she is joining a team that finished with a losing record last year and is picked to finish no better than seventh in the toughest conference in the nation.

Conway remains optimistic about the upcoming season.

"We'll surprise a lot of teams," she said. "Nobody is expecting us to do anything. We're the underdog, and I think that's a real good place to be."

Conway knows what her role is on this team and she hopes to make it a successful season for her and her teammates.

"I think I will bring to this team some senior experience, stability and some power offensively."
