

# Gymnasts to stop in Portland

Several of the gymnasts who wowed the crowds in Barcelona this summer are stopping in Portland as part of the 1992 Tour of Olympic and World Champion Gymnasts.

American standout Shannon Miller, who won five medals, will be joined by Tatiana Gutsu, Grigori Misutin and Svetlana Boguinskaya of the Unified team, as well as others from various countries. The Portland stop is set for Friday, Oct.

30 at 7:30 p.m. in the Memorial Coliseum.

The event is being billed as the largest lineup of international champion gymnasts to tour so extensively. The program will include routines on a variety of apparatuses.

# Aliens invading Oregon town

OAKLAND (AP) — Aliens or actors — the distinction is immaterial to the folks in this Oregon town. All they know is that these guys are pretty noisy in the morning.

A Paramount Pictures film crew has been in Oakland shooting the science fiction movie *Fire in the Sky*.

The film, scheduled for release in March, stars James Garner, D.B. Sweeney, who was featured in the TV miniseries *Lonesome Dove*, and Robert Patrick, who co-starred in *Terminator 2: Judgment Day*.

The script is based on the supposed true tale of a rowdy logger, played by Sweeney, whose encounter with aliens divides his small Arizona town.

Only it's Oregon, not Arizona. And these aliens are from Hollywood.

"Half the town really likes having them film here," said Marci Gorthy, who was directing

traffic away from a shoot Sept. 4.

"But the other half of town doesn't like having their regular routine disrupted. For them it's a real inconvenience," she said, as Sweeney roared by on a motorcycle being used in the scene.

"The other day, they were doing that at 5 o'clock in the morning, so there were some unhappy people," Gorthy said.

Paramount construction workers arrived in late August, boarding up windows and splashing dull paint on buildings to transform the quaint Victorian town of 875 people into ramshackle Snowflake, Ariz.

"I think overall, it's very positive for Oakland. We're lucky to draw the film companies," Gorthy said.

And residents involved in the filming say they're grateful for the work.
