### Willamette Science and Technology Center and Planetarium—

Photos of Venus from NASA's Magellan Space Probe will be displayed next month. Also, an exhibit titled "Simple Machines," will feature practical and impractical machines that we use — and don't use — such as a "Rube Goldberg," a machine that was built to serve no purpose. At the Planetarium, "Cosmic Catastrophes" is a show of violent and catastrophic events that do and could happen in space, such as meteor showers and stellar explosions. ### Maude Kearns Art Center Gallery—

Close to campus at 15th Avenue and Villard Street, the gallery features local professional artists. From Oct. 16 through Nov. 20, the Fourth Biennial

Oregon Made for Interiors show will exhibit furniture made from a variety of media. An opening reception will be on Oct. 16 from 7-9 p.m. and a symposium and panel discussion of the artists will be held Oct. 23 from 7-9 p.m.

### Oregon Aviation Museum—

For non-art lovers, this collection of historic bombers, twin-engine planes, and vintage stewardess uniforms should fire some engines. Located on Airport Road in Cottage Grove, the museum is open Wednesday through Sunday from 8 a.m.-4 p.m.

### Lane County Historical Museum and Research Library—

Featuring exhibits on Oregon's history, the museum is located at the Lane County Fairgrounds. In late September, "People of the Ancient Forests," an exhibit on the Molala Indians of the Cascade Mountains, will be on display. From Oct. 21 through Nov. 23, "Adventure and Encounter: Captain Gray on the Columbia" celebrates the 200th anniversary of the first charter up the Columbia River. Both shows are panel exhibits, featuring photos, cards, and maps. The museum is located at 740 W. 13th Avenue. Call 687-4239 for further details.

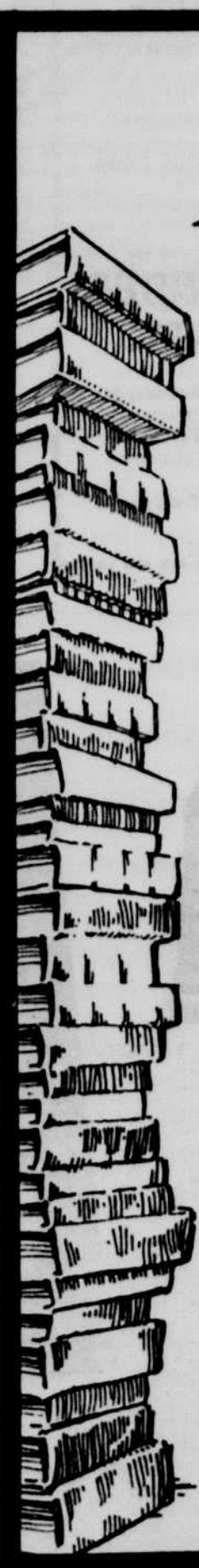
