'Backers anchor Duck defense

It's been a smiling season so far for junior Terrell Edwards

After Oregon's 59-6 victory over UNLV, Terrell Edwards came strolling into the interview room with a huge smile on his face as if he couldn't believe what had just happened.

Oregon's 6-foot-2, 226-pound linebacker laughed and joked his way through interviews.

"After the first two or three plays, I was thinking, 'Are these guys for real?" he said with a laugh.

He continued to smile throughout the arduously redundant task of answering questions and then marched back into the locker room ... with a smile.

Winning will do that to a player.

"I've always been a pretty cheerful guy," Edwards said. "I am a pretty easy guy to get along with."

Yeah, right. Try telling that to UNLV quarterback Bob Stockham, who had his head buried in the turf twice by Edwards.

Size doesn't keep Farwell from being the Pac-10's top tackler

When Oregon's opponents scout the Ducks, their eyes must light up when they see a 6-foot-2, 210-pound linebacker in the starting lineup.

That is the size of Oregon starting inside linebacker Joe Farwell, probably the lightest starting linebacker in the Pacific-10 Conference, if not the country.

Farwell, a senior, knows he does not fit the mold for the prototypical linebacker, but he said he makes up for his size with smarts.

"You can make up a lot of strength with technique," Farwell said. "It's not like I am a pushover. Some guys are Hercules in the weight room but get thrown all over the field. You have to be able to transfer what you do in the weight room onto the field."

Not too many people have thrown Farwell around this season, and despite missing Oregon's last game against UNLV, he still leads the team and Pacific-10 Conference in tackles. After three games, Farwell has 18 unassisted tackles and 18 assisted tackles, nine ahead of defensive lineman
