Saints tune it up

The Renegade Saints, a reincarnated version of Nine Days Wonder and Mission District, is having a tape release party tonight at John Henry's.

Emergency Broadcast System will open the show at 9:30 p.m.

Former Nine Days Wonder members Dave Coey (bass, vocals) and Mike Walker (organ, piano) joined forces with former Mission District's Matt Reynolds (drums), John Shipe (guitar, vocals) and Alan Toribio (guitar, vocals) to create this electrifying combination of skilled musicians.

Their first recording as a band, the new tape features 90 minutes of original tunes as testimony to the band's prolific songwriting. A Jimi Hendricks song is also included.

With four songwriters, The Saints couldn't help but end up with a tape that shows off their diversity.

One cut, "Know By Now," was recorded at the University's Folk Festival last spring. The tape also includes "The Deep End," a song about Edgar Allan Poe's famous last words ("God have mercy on my poor soul."). This song portrays the band's mellower acoustic side.

"Playing electric is our primary focus, but jamming acoustically freshens things up," Walker said.

"We're really happy with the tape because

everyone in the band had something to do with putting it together," Shipe said.

"It's more fun and more rewarding emotionally that way," Reynolds added.

However, at times the band was overly perfectionistic.

"We were comparing our \$500 tape to \$100,000 CDs, but all we really need to do is maintain our artistic integrity," Shipe said.

This demo tape is only a hint of what is yet to come. The Saints foresee completing a CD recording mid-1993. Meanwhile, they're going to "let it mature," they said.

The Renegade Saints pay tribute to all types of music, exploring the culture and emphasizing variety. Their repertoire defies the boundaries of genre and includes over 100 originals.

This Eugene band is becoming popular at a rate they didn't expect.

Since they made their debut at the WOW Hall last January, they have already had gigs with The Terraplanes, Uncle Chester, Peter Wilde and Bob Dylan, among others.

The band has recently signed up with Proton Productions, a big-time booking agency.

"It's all starting to come together. Now we have the time and mental attitude to be more creative," Coey said.

The Saints are in the midst of a 26-day tour throughout the Pacific Northwest. After tonight's show, they will take off until their performance at the WOW Hall with Little Women and The Aquarium Rescue Unit on Halloween.
