Saferide is a free night-time shuttle service for women. It is a safe alternative to walking alone at night, risking possible assault.

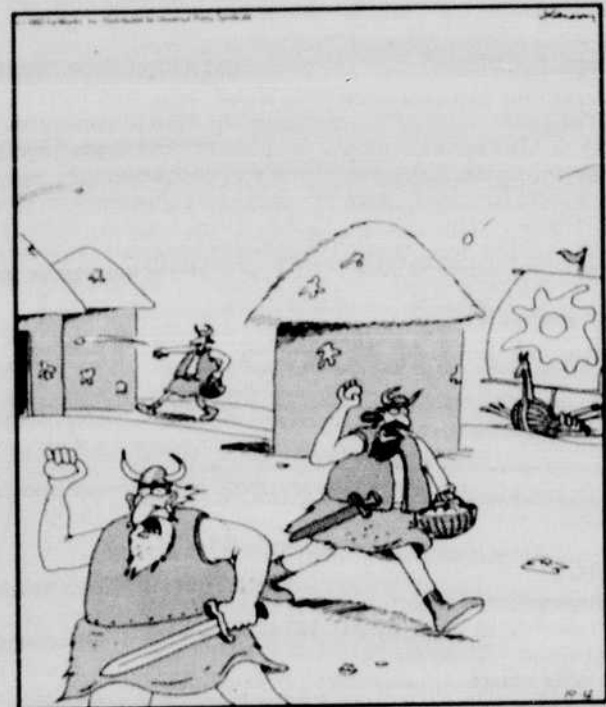
