NFL moves expansion date

CHICAGO (AP) - The NFL officially moved back its expansion date a year on Tuesday, saying for the first time that 1995 is the earliest the league can go to 30 teams.

In a statement declaring that it continues to be dedicated to expansion, the league said: "Current labor-management issues constitute an impediment to the expansion process and to the implementation of league expansion on the original timetable."

It was the first time the NFL flatly ruled out 1994, the target date the league had set for expanding by two teams. But Commissioner Paul

Tagliabue had strongly hinted a month ago in Dallas that unless some agreement was reached quickly on a labor contract, 1994 expansion would be unlikely.

In fact, while representatives of the five cities still in the expansion sweepstakes continued to lobby in the hallways of the hotel site of the meetings, the owners weren't even focusing on expansion.

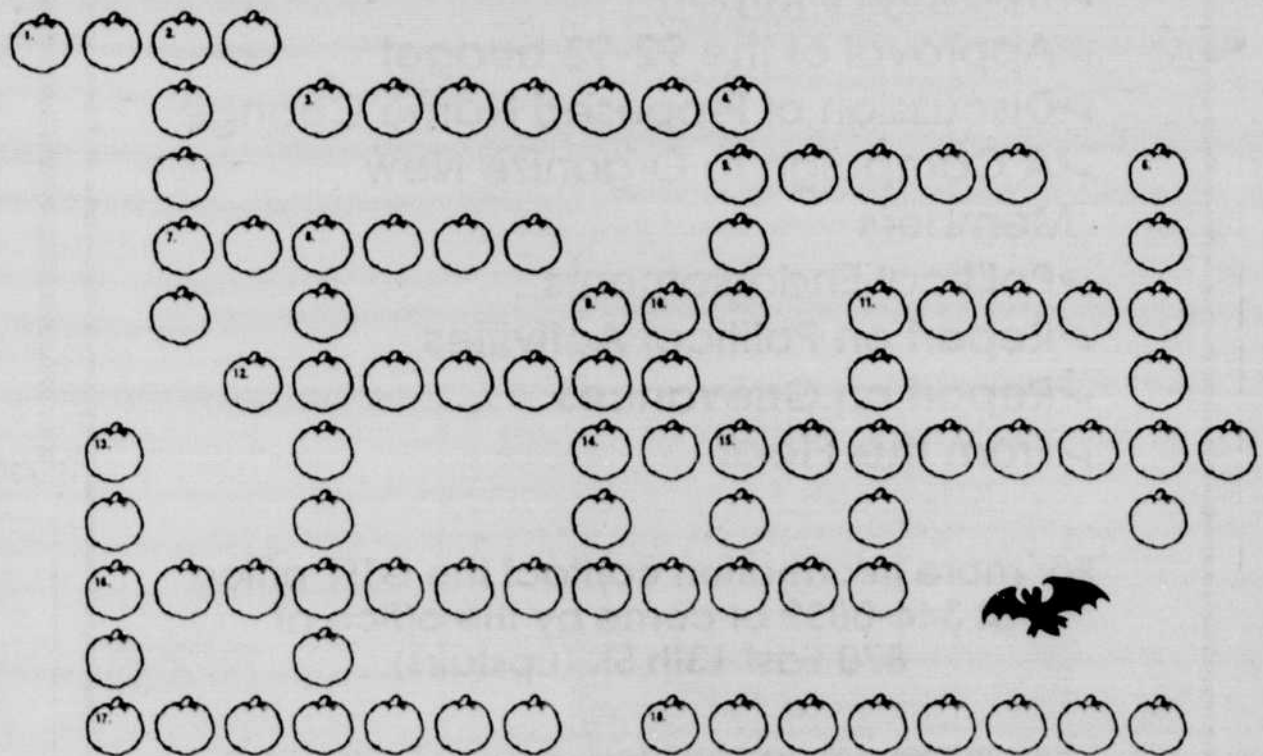
Instead, they were trying to find a formula to end the five-year labor stalemate that has postponed most of the NFL's major business.
